

Twin Rinks Spring Showdown Protocols & Guidance



- Non-vaccinated customers & anyone under the age of 15 must continue to wear masks both on & off the ice.
- Fully vaccinated customers do not need to wear masks on & off the ice. Fully vaccinated customers who are uncomfortable with the absence of masks are welcome to wear masks. A person is fully vaccinated when 14 days (2 weeks) have passed since their final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine (i.e. their second Pfizer or Moderna dose or their first Johnson & Johnson dose).
- Twin Rinks has the right to ask those not wearing masks for confirmation of vaccination. If confirmation can't be provided, the Twin Rinks staff has the right to mandate a mask to stay in the building.
 - Do not enter Twin Rinks, if you're:
 - Feeling or showing symptoms of any communicable disease
 - Waiting on the results of a COVID test
 - Considered "high-risk"
- Twin Rinks Staff, coaches, and instructors will continue to wear masks whether they have been vaccinated or not.
- Social distancing is still encouraged but the guest limit for skaters and participants has been removed.
- Locker rooms will be fully open for hockey programming and will be assigned on a per-event basis. Additional Locker rooms are available if needed. Chairs will remain available in the lobby areas if you are not comfortable using the locker rooms.
- Anthony's Kitchen & Iceview Tavern are open to full capacity.

Additional measures we are taking with our employees to ensure your safety:

- We continuing to take all employees' temperatures. Employees that have a fever will not be allowed to work.
- Provide information on vaccines: research on how they are developed and where to get vaccinated.
- In accordance with the City of Stamford Health Department, staff training on how to handle potential Covid-19 exposure in our facility has been updated.
