



Girls Showcase 2022 Tournament Rules

All games will be 3 Periods of 12 minutes stop time until semifinals and finals. Run time will commence in the 3rd period of any game with a 6 goal differential.

No timeouts in round robin or semifinal games, one timeout per team in the Championship game.

No Ties – Regulation ties during round robin play go immediately to a shootout. One shot per each team (3 shooters each to start) then single shooters until there is a winner. No shooters will repeat until all rostered players have shot.

Coaches please provide roster stickers at check in.

There will be tag up offsides at all levels.

Teams may ice the puck on a penalty kill at all levels.

Minor penalties are 2 minutes.

Majors are 5 minutes.

Teams must be ready to play 15 minutes before scheduled game time.

The Hockey Director will have final say on any decision that needs to be addressed, protests will not be tolerated.

All decisions made by on ice officials are final.

USA hockey rules will apply, unless amended above or below.

There will be 2 points awarded for a win, 1 point for a shootout or overtime loss, 0 points awarded for a regulation loss.

If two or more teams are tied in points at the end of round robin play the following will determine the standings:

If two teams are tied head to head will be the first tie breaker if applicable. If more than two teams tie, or if head to head is not applicable we will use the below tie breakers:

- 1) Wins
- 2) Regulation Wins
- 3) Least goals against
- 4) Most goals for
- 5) Least Penalty Minutes
- 6) Coin Toss

If there is a tie at the end of regulation time during the championship or semifinal game, the following rules will apply:

- 1) Four minutes of 3v3
- 2) If a tie persists, one shot per each team (3 shooters each to start) then single shooters until there is a winner. No shooters will repeat until all rostered players have shot.
